£80 a month could train a midwife

In Ethiopia only around 6% of all births are attended by skilled health personnel.

There are only 2 midwives for every 10,000 people in Ethiopia compared to 101 in the UK.

£100 could provide maternal health promotion for a community

Knowing the risks of pregnancy and childbirth and when to seek medical assistance can mean the difference between life and death.

£15 could provide a safe birth

On average it costs just £15 to provide a safe birth for a mother at a health centre or hospital. £1 could pay for a course of antibiotics to prevent infection after childbirth and £50 could pay for an emergency caesarean.
