

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

INSEAD Malawi Bike Ride
23rd September – 1st October 2017

Costs and Fundraising

1. For this challenge we require a deposit of £300 (non- refundable) to reserve your place, to be accompanied by your completed online Registration.
2. You agree to pay a total of £1,795 to cover your costs for taking part in this trip and have read and understood the cancellation policy. You agree to pay the final balance (£1,495 plus single supplement if applicable) on or before 1st July 2017, failure to do so will result in cancellation of your place.
3. Of costs paid £1,795 will be used to cover the costs of your; accommodation, food, transport, bike hire and support team.
4. Travel to and from Chileka Airport, Malawi are at your own expense.
5. You participate at your own risk. If you are refused passage and/or entry/exit to or from Malawi, any additional costs incurred are your responsibility.
6. By registering in this challenge you are pledging to raise the team fundraising target of £26,316 and understand that it is the endeavour of this challenge to raise as much as possible in aid of Maternity Worldwide.
7. Should you have to withdraw, there will be no fundraising refund payable to you as your fundraising was raised for charitable purposes.

Health, Insurance, Safety, Passports, Visas

8. You must be at least 18 years old before the departure date of the event.
9. You are required to complete a medical questionnaire; if you are aged 65+ you will need to obtain a Doctor's signature on your medical questionnaire before your place on the tour is confirmed. If you have a medical condition the trip doctor may require that you obtain a Doctor's signature before your place on the tour is confirmed. If your health changes after signing the form, you hereby agree to inform the charity immediately and you understand that a new medical form may be required.
10. You are responsible for seeking and following the advice of medical staff in your country with regards to preparation for the ride including vaccinations and malaria prophylaxis. If you choose not to follow the advice given you must declare this on your Medical Form.
11. You must wear a cycling helmet at all times when cycling during the event.
12. This is an active challenge and by registering for the event you pledge to undertake a serious training regime to achieve the best possible fitness for the challenge. You should be able to cycle up to 70km per day.
13. You agree to discontinue cycling on any particular day or for the whole event if it is judged by the Maternity Worldwide or Land and Lakes team or representatives that continuing would potentially endanger your own safety or that of other riders or staff.
14. You must not suffer from alcohol or drug dependency.

15. You must have adequate travel insurance that will cover you for the specific activities you will be undertaking, including emergency repatriation to your home country from remote locations. You will be asked to provide proof of travel insurance 8 weeks before the departure date or you may forfeit your place on the trip.
16. If you withdraw in circumstances where recovery of cancellation charges is indemnified under your travel insurance, you hereby agree that you will co-operate in the recovery of these charges from the insurers and any sums recovered under the policy will be paid to the charity. If the insurance company does not recognise your claim, you will be responsible for covering any cancellation charges borne by the charity.
17. Your passport must have at least six months to run from the date you return to your country.
18. It is your responsibility to apply for a visa before the trip.
19. You will be responsible for providing your own personal safety equipment such as a bike helmet and suitable cycling clothes.
20. You understand that equipment and personal belongings are brought at your own risk. The local organiser Land and Lakes and Maternity Worldwide accept no responsibility for damage or theft to a participant's personal belongings.
21. You understand your photograph may be taken whilst on the ride and may be used for Maternity Worldwide promotional purposes. You agree to notify Maternity Worldwide if you do not wish your photograph to be taken or used for this purpose.

Changes and Cancellation

22. Itineraries, schedules and accommodation may change and other alterations may occur which are beyond the control of Land and Lakes or Maternity Worldwide. Land and Lakes and Maternity Worldwide are unable to accept liability for any loss or damage; however arising, or for cancellation of the event for any reasons outside their control.
23. Maternity Worldwide and Land and Lakes may, at their sole discretion, withdraw places on the challenge if it is believed to be in their or the participants' best interest to do so.
24. You understand that if you need to withdraw from your place your £300 deposit is non-refundable. If you withdraw between 1st July 2017 and 31st July 2017 you will be entitled to 30% refund. If you withdraw after 1st August 2017 you will not be entitled to any refund.
25. You understand that by registering for the INSEAD Malawi Bike Ride 2017 you are therefore agreeing to adhere to these Conditions of Entry.
